

## **Call for County Convention for the Constitution Party of South Carolina, Year of our Lord, 2025**

Constitution Party of SC, Greenville County Convention (for reorganization only) will be held on the 19th day of April 2025, 10 a.m. at the Taylors Public Library (Burdette Branch) 316 W Main St. Taylors SC, by call of the chairman of the Greenville County Constitution Party Committee.

When called to order by the current County Chairman, duly appointed delegates to the Greenville County Convention will do the following: 1. Elect a temporary president, temporary secretary, and a committee on credentials for the purpose of organizing. The same person may hold more than one of these offices; 2. The committee on credentials will report to the temporary president the list of credentialed delegates to the county convention from the precincts as approved by the State Committee. 3. Elect a permanent president, a secretary, and treasurer of the county convention. The same person may hold more than one of these offices; 4. Elect a county chairman, county vice-chairman, and a member of the State Committee from the county. The county chairman, county vice-chairman, and the county member of the State Committee comprise the County Committee. Note that the same person may hold more than one of these offices; 5. Elect delegates to the state convention. Each county is entitled to one delegate for each six thousand residents of the county, according to the latest official United States Census, plus two additional members. If a county has a fractional portion of population of at least three thousand residents above its last six thousand resident figure it is entitled to an additional delegate.

The secretary of the convention shall keep a record of the proceedings in the minute book. All officers except delegates shall be reported to the clerk of court of the county and to the Secretary of State prior to the state convention. The reports shall be public record.

Upon completion of business, the convention will be recessed by motion (not adjourned) until reconvened in March 2026 by the County Chairman with at least two weeks notice to delegates. This is to allow the convention to reconvene by March 31 of 2026 for the purpose of nominating candidates to the 2026 general election for political office in that county.
